Signalling is communicating with other road users.

As well as the indicators (or blinkers), other signals provided with modern cars are:

- Brake lights – operated by pressing the brake pedal.
- Reversing lights – operated by selecting reverse.
- Headlight flashers.
- Hazard lights (all indicator lights flashing together).
