12 a Airbags will NOT protect you if a seat belt is not worn.

Note:

- Seatbelts **MUST** be worn and properly adjusted. Seats that do not have seat belts in working condition must **NOT** be used.
- Airbags will **NOT** protect you unless a seatbelt is worn. If you don't wear a seatbelt, you could be pushed into the airbag as it inflates at 200km/h.
- Children up to the age of 7 years must be in the back seat.
- Children under 12 months of age should be in a baby capsule which complies with Australian standards. The capsule **MUST** be attached to the proper mounting points provided in your car.
- Do not ride in load spaces that do not have seats with seatbelts, such as the backs of utes or station wagons. Tie dogs up so that they cannot jump out.
- Many people who died in crashes while not wearing seatbelts, could still be alive if they had been wearing a seatbelt.
