Note:

- You must drive with the headlights on between sunset and sunrise, or when daytime visibility is poor due to fog, heavy rain etc.
- When parked, only have the parking lights on, headlights will dazzle other drivers. The road rules say that lights must not be used to dazzle other drivers.
- Headlights can drain the battery quickly if the engine is off (the car battery is only charged while the engine is running).
